- There will be some reshuffling of teachers. All the changes are initiated by the teachers. These changes will play to our teacher's strengths and background.

- \circ Searching for a 3rd grade teacher.
- Enrollment numbers are strong! 3rd grade, 4th grade, 8th grade full for next year. Kindergarten will be full soon.
- Inspire classrooms have been re-worked based on feedback from the committee. This upcoming year will be a road map to see if Inspire fits the needs of Immanuel moving forward.
- Preschool Update: Enrollment is at capacity for 2025-2026 school year with the exception of a few part-time spots. Still scheduling tours. Waitlist for any full-time spots.
- New opportunities have been introduced this year for pre-school including the very successful Fall Fair, Art Fair and the Upcoming Touch-a-Truck event.
- We chose not to purchase the CPH curriculum for early childhood (not age appropriate), and we created our own. The savings were used to purchase Children's Literature. We have an app that has been created for the teachers so they can pull up a new curriculum based on what the child is leading them through during the day.

Voter's Meeting & Proposed Changes to Constitution & Bylaws—Dennis Rohlfing

- Proposed Changes were ratified on 2/2/25!
- Dr. Hagen's office has confirmed receipt of all 5 documents.
 - The committee review will take place on 4/24/25. If it passes, District committee review will take place on 5/7/25.
 - Next step will be to begin the review of policy manuals. The church policy manual will be addressed first and then the school policy manual.

DCE Call Committee-Pastor Taylor

 3 secondary interviews set up for this week. This part of the interview process focuses on their ministry style. 2 of the 3 candidates have at least 6 years' experience already. Good news! Things are happening. Voter's meeting will be on April 6th to get congregational approval to extend the call.
